Extension 1- Reader Response

Materials:

Paper

Pencil

Crayons, Markers, Color Pencils or Paint

Props for acting out

OR NOTHING--You can act it out or talk about it without any materials.

Learning Targets:

I can write about my connection to the story.

I can write to tell my thoughts about the story.

★To start:

Reading Response Task Card

We just finished reading the book, “Beautiful Oops”
It’s time for you to respond to what you have read.

You have two choices to respond to:

1. Can you tell about a time that you made a mistake but you turned it into something beautiful?
2. What was your favorite “oops” and why? What would you have turned that “oops”, or mistake, into if it happened to you?

Extension 2 - Torn Paper Art

Materials:

2 sheets of paper- different colors

Learning Targets:

I can think creatively about how to create something from scrap paper.

I can create art from a “mistake.”

★To start:

1. You will need two different colors of paper. One color will be the paper you draw and create on. Tear the second page into pieces of any size.
2. Pick 1 of the torn pieces. Glue it to the paper you are going to create/draw on. You can glue it anywhere.
3. Now look at the page with the “mistake” or “oops” glued on top of it. Turn that sheet in every direction and look at it from many angles.
4. What can that shape turn into? Create your “Beautiful Oops!”
